



THANK YOU FOR STAYING COVID-SAFE



In line with the NSW government restrictions for re-opening, Club Hazelbrook will be operating with the following conditions:

- All members and guests must be fully vaccinated (at least 2 doses) or have a medical contraindication certificate of exemption
 - You will be required to show proof of vaccination or exemption at any time, and upon entry. If you do not have an electronic copy (such as through ServiceNSW [when available] or the Medicare app) you may print a copy and carry a paper version with you
 - We will not keep a record of vaccinated or exempt members, so you must have it available each time you visit the club
 - Guests under the age of 16 are not required to be fully vaccinated, but must be in the company of a fully vaccinated household member at all times
- If you feel unwell, please STAY HOME and get tested, even if you do not have any COVID-19 symptoms
- Our venue capacity will be decreasing again to 1 person per 4 square metres
- Members and guests must be 1.5 metres apart from other groups. Please do not approach other tables
- All members and guests must wear a mask at all times while indoors, unless eating or drinking (including between drinks or while approaching the bar/bistro). This includes our indoor gaming area
- There is some debate still about wearing masks outdoors while on the greens, however our members are encouraged to keep one on them at all times and maintain a distance from others while outside. Spectators will be required to wear masks when not actively eating or drinking
- Single-use masks are available upon request if you require one
- You will still be required to check in using the ServiceNSW QR code. If your phone or tablet is unable to read a QR code, check in is available at the Bar
- If you do not have proof of vaccination or refuse a mask, we will ask you to leave
- Our staff are aware of the rules and have authority to request you to comply with them. Any abuse of our staff (including verbal) will not be tolerated and you will be asked to leave.
