Hello Members,

Long time, no speak! It has certainly been longer than anyone could have expected but here we are- three months after a snap lockdown and we are so eager to be able to welcome you all back.

So let's get the housekeeping out of the way: In accordance with the NSW Government policy on reopening, Club Hazelbrook will only be able to admit fully vaccinated (at least 2 doses) persons on to the premises. This includes both the Clubhouse and the Greens/viewing areas.

As part of this you will need to carry with you your vaccination certificate or a medical contraindication certificate to show you are exempt. Please bring this every time you come to the Club. Some information on how to access your vaccination certificate is attached.

As before, masks are required indoors as well as outdoors when you are not eating or drinking. This means that in our gaming area, on our back deck *and* in the Bistro and Bar area, a mask must be worn unless you are eating or drinking. You must wear a mask to approach the Bar or Bistro, or if using the bathroom facilities.

All Members are reminded that it is our staff's job to tell you to put a mask on, or to ask you to show proof of vaccination (or exemption) otherwise the Club could face a heavy fine. If you believe you have a valid exemption to wearing a mask, simply let us know. If you do not have a valid reason and refuse to wear one, our staff reserve the right to ask you to leave the Club premises until you return with a mask. The same is required if you do not bring proof of vaccination/exemption -you must leave the Club immediately and return with your proof.

Finally, if you feel unwell, please do not come to the Club. Stay home even if you do not have Covid-19 symptoms, and get tested at the earliest opportunity. This is the only way our community can ensure we keep each other safe.

In order to keep everyone safe, we will have designated seating times with a 2 hour dining window until COVID restrictions are eased. Takeaway is available, and you can call ahead and place an order via phone for pickup – a perfect option for those who haven't yet received their 2nd vaccine dose.

Please note, the bistro will not have table service - take a buzzer when you order and collect your meals from the counter when ready.
